

# European Studies Book Award

The European Studies Book Award honors the work of new scholars, and is awarded to the best first book on any subject in European Studies published within a two-year period. The winner receives **\$1000** in prize money and travel assistance to attend the annual CES International Conference of Europeanists. Both the winner and top two finalists will be recognized in CES's publications, and on our website.

Nominations may be submitted by the publisher, author, or admiring colleague, and must be accompanied by seven copies of the nominated title, separately mailed to the Council for European Studies and the six members of its Book Award Committee.

## Eligibility

Each nominated title must meet the following criteria:

- Must be the **first book** written by the nominee in the field of European Studies
- Must be published between **Oct. 1, 2013 and Sept. 30, 2015**
- **Must not** be a reprint or re-edition of a previously published book
- Must be the work of a **single** author
- Must be **a member of the CES** or hold a full-time faculty appointment at a **member institution**

## Deadlines

Nomination period opens **July 1, 2016**  
All nominations are due **October 1, 2017**
